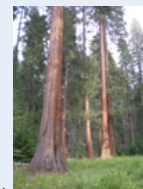

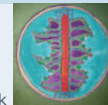

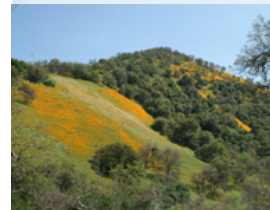

A WORD TO THE WISE...

The header photograph was taken on the Dinely Bridge looking downstream. It subtly and beautifully emphasizes the crux of humans living on the edge of the natural world. Much of the vegetation to the left of the river (you can see a bit of bright yellow color) is an invasive plant known as broom. These plants escaped from human gardens in Three Rivers and found a perfect, well draining, seasonally well watered home to propagate themselves. In doing so, they have forced out the native vegetation, like bush lupine, and we no longer can see this place as it was. Be careful and be informed about what you plant in your gardens when you live in a place like this village
